**RECONSTITUTING AND REVITALIZING THE MUNICIPAL ANTI-DRUG ABUSE COUNCILS (MADAC) OF
PURA, TARLAC.**

WHEREAS, DILG Regional Memorandum Circular No. 2012-94, dated May 21, 2012 reiterates the strengthening/revitalizing of Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (MADAC) in all levels of local governments in support to the continuing campaign of the government in the fight against illegal drugs;

WHEREAS, the Circular aims to achieve an integrated approach to eliminate the proliferation and use of illegal drugs in order to promote peace and order and to have a meaningful social and economic development in the country;

WHEREAS, the present administration is supportive of this thrust and is determined to push through and implement programs and activities that would ensure the strict implementation of Republic Act 9165, otherwise known as the Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CONCEPCION A. ZARATE, Municipal Mayor of Pura in the Province of Tarlac, do hereby decree that:

Section 1. The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Councils (MADAC) of Pura is hereby revitalized and reconstituted as follows:

Section 2. The MADAC shall perform the following duties and functions without compensation or remuneration:

Pre-Operations

- a. Shall activate the anti-drug abuse council;
- b. Prepare Action Plan;
- c. Undertake capability enhancement activities of all stakeholders;
- d. Organization of home clusters;
- e. Submission of BADAC Chairman for consolidation;
- f. Determination of priority drug affected barangays;
- g. Enactment of ordinance creating Administrative Boards;
- h. Establishment of rehabilitation/referral desks;

During Operations

- a. Witness the inventory of seized drugs/paraphernalia;
- b. Conduct of advocacy and prevention education;
- c. Processing of applications for rehabilitation of drug dependent;
- d. Upon information from PDEA, conduct administrative searches of suspected drug dens/laboratories;


Post-Operations

- a. Identification/implementation of sustainable projects;
- b. Submission of monthly reports on anti-drug activities;

Section 3. The Municipal Anti-Drug Abuse Council shall meet at least once every quarter or as often as necessary.

Section 4. This Order shall take effect immediately.
